ITEEA Journals Undergo Name Changes

RESTON, Virginia, April 22, 2010 - The International Technology and Engineering Educators Association (ITEEA) has announced a name change for each of its major journals to better reflect the inclusion of engineering education.

The Technology Teacher will be renamed Technology and Engineering Teacher effective with Volume 60, #1, which has a September 2010 distribution. While keeping many of its regular features in place, the editorial staff plans to include more articles that highlight engineering education and its relationship, along with technology education, as an integral part of a solid STEM education.

Technology and Children will become Children's Technology and Engineering effective with the Volume 15, #1 issue at the same time. The overarching theme for the 2010-2011 publishing year of Children's Technology and Engineering is Engineering, with subthemes including "Mechanical Engineering: Making Things Move"; "Aerospace Engineering: Air and Space"; "Environmental Engineering: Protecting Our Planet"; and "Civil Engineering: Buildings and Structures."

The journal name changes follow a March 1, 2010 name change for the association from the International Technology Education Association to the International Technology and Engineering Educators Association, following an 81% majority vote by the association's members.
